Course

This hands-on class will teach opaque painting techniques that can be used with a multitude of paint mediums such as gouache, acrylic, and pigment dense water colors. Students will receive an introduction to color blocking, silhouette development, and color theory.

The class will focus on 3D (live objects) conversion to 2D (flat objects) using opaque mediums such as acrylic paints.

The following supplies are required to be purchased separately by the participants prior to class:

- 11 x 14 mixed medium sketch pad
- 2 round acrylic medium brushes
- 1 large round acrylic brush
- 2 mechanical pencils
- 1 kneaded eraser
- 1 palette tray
- 1 water container

Acrylic beginner set of paint – minimum of 5 colors with basics (red, yellow, blue, black and white)
